The EBA published the latest report on incorporation of ESG risks in the supervision of investment firms (EBA/REP/2022/26).

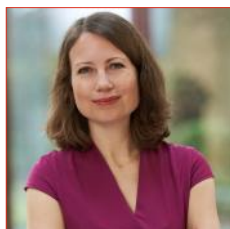
