Webinar Objective

The webinar will also highlight areas where current IFRS 9 practices intersect with broader prudential and IRB considerations, making it particularly relevant for professionals engaged in credit risk, modelling, regulatory compliance, and financial reporting.

The topics for discussion will include:

IFRS 9 Provisioning Approaches and Benchmarking as of the 2025 Financial Year-End:

- Management overlays across European banks, including their use and underlying rationale.
- Benchmarking of IFRS 9 risk drivers, including coverage-ratio dynamics, risk parameters across products, and current modelling practices, with selected reference to prudential and IRB considerations.
- Macroeconomic accounting, including the number and weighting of scenarios and their application in LGD and CCF parameters.
- Approaches to the accounting for novel risks.

ECB On-site Inspection (OSI) Findings on IFRS 9:

- Analysis of the severity and nature of OSI findings.
- Key areas of regulatory concern.
