One more time for old time's sake: EBA publishes stress test methodology for 2023

A closer look at the 2023 methodology.

On July 21st, the EBA published its revised **stress test methodology** for the 2023 EU banking stress test. Following a consultation paper on the **future of the supervisory stress test** published in 2020 and after the hiatus enforced by the COVID crisis, it had been expected that the new methodology would be a big step towards a complete overhaul of the requirements. However, EBA now decided on a step-by-step approach with the big steps still to come in the future. Having said that, it is of course still worth to have a look at the 2023 methodology in a bit more detail.
